Vineyard:	Growers Mark is the wine deemed the best by the winemaking and viticutrural team at Farmers Market. Always from a single vineyard source, these grapes were grown by Paul Tietjen in the golden sloes in Ormond.
Vinification:	Due th this varieties high natural acidity, the grapes are in contact with the skin for 8 hours to naturally deacidify the juice. The juice is then pressed, floated and inoculated with yeast. Cool fermented, the fermentation is stopped when the wine is deemed in balance. The wine is then stabilised and bottled.
Appearance:	Hints of green and gold.
Bouquet:	Almond essence with herbaceous notes.
Palate:	Almonds, apricots and green apple with firm acidity.
Cellaring:	3 years
