Vineyard: This wine was sourced from our Claim 431 Vineyard in

the Bendigo sub-region of CentralOtago. The vineyards free draining loam soils over schist gravel make it a natural home forgrowing outstanding Pinot Noir. The huge diurnal temperature variation, adds to the structure

and fruit concentration of the wine.

Vinification: After a warm, early start to the season, an unusually cold

November saw snow fall on themountains putting mother nature on hold for a while. Thankfully, a warm December through toFebruary followed, which allowed the vines to catch up. The drier than usual season wascharacterised by a short and sweet harvest which produced delightful

ripeness and brightaromatics.

Appearance: Deep ruby red.

Bouquet: Aromas of red cherry, dried herbs, scented oak and

vibrant spice.

Palate: Smooth on the palate with dark cherry and bramble

flavours delivering a long finish with fine tannins and

balanced acidity.
