

MUD HOUSE Sub Region Pinot Noir 2021

Vineyard: Sub Region: The Narrows. Located at the narrowing of

the upper Wairau Valley with lovely north facing aspects. The coolness of the area combined with the airflow created by the river, allos a longer, slower ripening

season.

Vinification: Grapes were hand picked, then gently destemmed,

followed by a week long cold soak. Each parcel was fermented using indigenous yeast, then hand plunged to extract vibrant flavour and delicate tannin structure. The

wine was finished using traditional methods.

Appearance: Ruby red.

Bouquet: Dark cherry and berries with subtle sweet oak spice.

Palate: Soft dark fruit is followed by a hint of savoury bramble

berries. Juicy acidity and soft tannins offer a lingering

finish.
