<b>Vineyard:</b>	Bendigo, the warmest of the sub regions of Central Otago with its semi-arid climate, lies northeast of Cromwell, and east of the Clutha River and Lake Dunstan. There are three terraces and 10 clones; vines planted on the gentle, stony, free draining north-facing slopes with altitudes ranging from 200 - 350 metres. The soils, mostly shallow, are composed of clay, gravel and quartz, known for producing Pinot Noir rich in flavour with structured tannins and depth through the palate.
<b>Palate:</b>	Elegant dark cherry fruit notes and chalky graphic-like tannins are woven together with sinewy acidity.
