## Robertson Pinot Gris 2019



<b>Category:</b>	WINE
<b>Style:</b>	WHITE WINE
<b>Variety:</b>	PINOT GRIS
<b>Region:</b>	HAWKES BAY
<b>Vintage:</b>	2019
<b>Volume:</b>	750ml
<b>Vineyard:</b>	All the grapes come from Ohiti Estate which is owned by Brookfields Vineyards, and is situated in an inland heat trap on the former bed of the old Ngaruroro River. Trained on classical VSP trellis system, on arid alluvial soils, the Pinot Gris ripens well, producing clean fruit with full flavours, good extract, and moderate acid. The 2019 growing season was very good a vintage year. Hence the flavour development is concentrated.
<b>Vinification:</b>	On arrival at the winery on the 24th and 27th of March, the fruit was pressed as soon as possible. The free run was kept separate from the pressings. After overnight cold settling, the clear juice was inoculated with an aromatic yeast strain, and fermented at cool temperatures. Following completion of fermentation, the wine remained on its gross lees for texture and flavour enhancement, with weekly lees stirring.
<b>Appearance:</b>	Pale straw colour
<b>Bouquet:</b>	The 2019 Robertson Pinot Gris has refreshing pear, peach and spice and finishes with a splash of wild honey.
<b>Palate:</b>	While it is nearly dry there is sweet fruit and fresh flavours which make it an excellent food wine.
<b>Cellaring:</b>	6 years
