Vineyard:	The vineyard is a mix of Mass Selection (MS) and Clone 470 however the Hillside blend is mostly the 470 clone. Both clones ripen at the same time however their growth is different, the 470 clone is more vertical than the Mass Selection which is not so regimented. The 470 clones yields are generally lighter than the MS.		
Vinification:	Harvested on the 7th April, the intensely flavoured Syrah was destemmed, crushed and fermented in closed fermentation tanks. Following pressing, the wine underwent malolactic fermentation and was then racked into new French. Then taken out of barrel seventeen months later, it was estate bottled.		
Appearance:	Intense red wine with magenta meniscus.		
Bouquet:	The 2018 Hillside Syrah is dark and fragrant with Damson plum, black pepper, leather, black current, French oak and ripe supple tannins.		
Palate:	It is made largely from the 470 clone of Syrah which is renowned for its colour and concentration and aged in mainly new French oak barriques. Elegantly balanced, it is seamlessly majestic cellaring will reward.
