Central Otago Pinot Noir 2021

Vineyard: The Pinot Noir grapes from our family-owned Someones Darling vineyard in Central Otago. Here, the soil type is free-draining sandy loam over schist alluvium gravels known as Molyneux soils. The Dijon clones give the wine nice floral notes, while Abel and Pommard provide structure. 10% of the grapes are from the Loveblock Farm in Marlborough.

Vinification: Grapes were harvested in early morning by machine in April. At the winery, the fruit was pumped straight to the tank, without crushing, in order to leave some whole berries. After a five-day cold soak, the must was warmed to 20C and fermentation commenced on its own wild yeast. The ferment was hand plunged twice daily until dry when it was pressed off. The wine then underwent full malolactic fermentation in tank. A portion of the wine was aged on oak. After eight months of maturation, the wine

Appearance: Bright crimson

Bouquet: Big, ripe black cherry with hints of mushroom and toasty oak spice peeking out behind rich fruit

Palate: Fleshy black plum, with layers of cherry and sweet berries that play on the palate and dance with hints of violet and savoury notes
