Vinification: 2015/2016 growing season had below average rainfall.

> Mean average temperatures were also consistently above average. A timely rainfall event in early February refreshed the vines and slowed sugar accumulation as they entered the final stages of

ripening, resulting in a vibrant varietal fruit flavour.

**Bouquet:** The 2016 Sangiovese Rose is brimming with cranberry

and strawberry aromas.

Palate: The palate explodes with the flavours of fresh juicy
