## Ned & Henry Shiraz 2014



<b>Category:</b>	WINE
<b>Style:</b>	RED WINE

<b>Vineyard:</b>	Named after Miss Harrys older brothers. Every vine is grown on terra rossa red soil over limestone. French oak, full-bodied with finesse.
<b>Vinification:</b>	A good friend of mine challenged me to produce a traditional, full-bodied Barossa Valley wine that could be drunk young at dinner and did not stray from my fundamental wine making philosophies. Thus Ned Henrys was born. Classic terra rossa vineyards provide the fruit for Ned and Henrys. The vineyards are traditionally grown low cropped. After traditional fermentation the wine is pressed into quality seasoned French barriques, where the wine finishes fermentation and malolactic fermentation
<b>Appearance:</b>	Deep, bright red/purple hue.
<b>Bouquet:</b>	Red cherry, almost cassis-like aroma, emphasising richly ripe fruit.
<b>Palate:</b>	The 2014 vintage provided perfect conditions for Shiraz from the Barossa Valley. All from terra rossa soils, millions of years of oxidized iron red soils over limestone, this wine is classically Ned Henrys and one of our best vintages. This is a red drinkers red at all levels, generous, full bodied, rich red and black fruits, fabulous tannins.
