Vineyard:	The reclusive Alan Webster lived alone in the years after the second world war in the scrubland behind the Kilikanoon cellar door, west of the hamlet of Penwortham. Trapping rabbits, growing his own fruits and vegetables and making his own wines in a galvanised lean to, he was given the nickname Killerman by Mort Mitchell and his friends when they were growing up, after Alans bush survival skills of kill em and eat em, thus the legend of Killerman was born.
Appearance:	Brick red in colour with bright crimson hues.
Bouquet:	Fresh berries, cassis, toasty French oak and hints of choc mint combine seductively on the nose.
Palate:	Packed full of fresh berries, riper blackcurrent notes and inviting dark chocolateswirl and complex with fine grained tannins, subtle oak char and firm acidity in a long and rewarding palate finish. A wine readily enjoyed now but will further reward careful cellaring.
