<b>Vineyard:</b>	Established by John Reynell in 1838, the Reynella winery enjoys the unrivalled prestige of being the birthplace of South Australia's internationally renowned wine industry, and is the proud home of the State's oldest operating wine cellar. Today the headquarters of Accolade Wines is set on 21 picturesque hectares at the gateway to the famous McLaren Vale wine region. This historic winery exudes classic charm with its restored heritage.
<b>Vinification:</b>	2013 vintage saw the return of traditional South Australian climate with a cool damp Winter and hot dry Summer. Meticulous vineyard management practices ensured that the fruit survived high temperatures and produced high quality fruit with impressive varietal characteristics. Picking at optimum maturity has resulted in wines which display vibrant colours with ripe flavour profiles, rounded flavoursome palates and soft fine tannins.
<b>Appearance:</b>	Brilliant, dark red with scarlet hue.
<b>Bouquet:</b>	Intense aromatics of violets, red currants and dark cherries combine with more subtle tones of black olive and mocha. This is all well supported by notes of cedar and spice derived from French oak maturation.
<b>Palate:</b>	A deep brooding wine showing impressive intensity of rich dark fruit, a softly textured and vibrant mid palate balanced by soft acid and fine grain tannins.
