Vineyard:	The BV Vineyard was planted in 1992 on micaceous schist soils on the western escarpment of Mt. Barker on the eastern edge of the Adelaide Hills. The climate and soils of this vineyard closely resemble those of the Cote Rotie in the Northern Rhone Valley where Shiraz is one of the native varieties.		
Vinification:	The fruit was transported from the vineyard to the winery; destemmed, crushed and chilled to Potter heading-down-board fermenters. After cold soaking for five days, the chosen yeast strain was added. Once a day the fermenting juice was drained off to another tank, and then pumped back up. After two weeks on skins, the skins were pressed and the resultant wine pumped into barrel. A total of 17 months in oak - 65% French Oak 35% new oak used.		
Bouquet:	A big brooding spicy aromatic, cool climate Shiraz. Fragrant black pepper and spices mix with dark red fruits and delicate cedar oak.		
Palate:	The palate is rich and full, with lovely deep dark berries and spice and pepper. Dark mocha chocolate and bright soft sandy tannins herald a lightly smoky coffee finish.
