<b>Vineyard:</b>	Nurtured in unique soils that are home to large stones polished over the centuries, this is a blend of Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah and Cinsault.		
<b>Vinification:</b>	The grapes are hand-picked and partially destemmed before fermentation. Each grape variety is fermented individually and fermentation/maceration lasts for approximately 4 weeks in cement vats. After about 12 months of maturing, the different varieties, which were aged partly in oak and partly in vat, are combined to form the final blend before bottling.		
<b>Bouquet:</b>	An elegant nose of prune, fig and caramel.		
<b>Palate:</b>	This Châteauneuf du Pape opens with notes of ripe strawberry and spice complemented by dark fruit flavours and silky tannins
