<b>Style:</b>	RED WINE

<b>Vineyard:</b>	This wine is a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvire grapes grown in a stony soil of quartz mixed with sandy red clay.
<b>Vinification:</b>	The grapes are hand-picked and fully destemmed before fermentation. Each grape variety is fermented individually and fermentation/maceration lasts for approximately 4 weeks. After about 12 months of maturing, the different varieties, which were aged partly in oak and partly in vat, are combined to form the final blend before bottling.
<b>Appearance:</b>	A rich, bright ruby colour.
<b>Bouquet:</b>	A subtle and complex nose of ripe strawberry and Provenal herbs.
<b>Palate:</b>	The palate is full and structured with dark-fruit flavours of spicy plum and black cherry complemented by smooth, silky tannins on the finish. Enjoy this Chateauneuf du Pape with roasted game, duck fillet or cheese. Serve between 16C and 18C. Can be enjoyed already and up to 10 years of age
