Vineyard:	The vineyard is located at an altitude of 80-120 meters, with a Mediterranean climate. It features clay and limestone soils with gravel, and the vines are over 45 years old. The vineyard follows the Cordon de Royat pruning method and has a planting density of 4,400 plants per hectare. The grapes are hand-picked, with an average yield of 52 hectoliters per hectare.

Appearance:	Intense deep purple colour with ruby red tints.		
Bouquet:	At first spices and blackberry, the second nose develops underwood and cocoa aromas finishing on toasted oak notes.		
Palate:	Full bodied rich and mellow with velvety tannins. Complex flavours on the middle palate, liquorice flavours on the finish. Long lasting. If kept in good conditions (15C and bottle laying down) this wine will age perfectly for the next 5 years.
