Vineyard:	Each appellation selected by the Baron Philippe de Rothschild team has a unique terroir, giving it an exceptional range of nuances for making Mouton CadetvHéritage . The limestone soils of Entre Deux Mers and the Premières Côtes de Bordeaux produce wines of refinement, while the clay soils around Blaye give fuller bodied wines. The gravelly soils of Côtes de Bourg and the south of Entre Deux Mers bring elegance and freshness to the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes.		
Vinification:	Baron Philippe de Rothschilds winemakers regularly taste the grapes from each selected parcel in order to determine the optimum harvest date . The grapes from each parcel are then vinified separately to preserve the diversity and personality of each terroir and each grape variety, and hence to offer the widest range of options for final blending. The vinification process is adapted to each vatt ing to optimize the extraction of tannins and the expression of fruit that give Mouton Cad		
Appearance:	An intense garnet red with a slight crimson hue.		
Bouquet:	The nose opens on a mixture of black and red fruit, especially blackberry, bilberry and candied cherry, then with airing goes on to display delicate touches of spice and blackcurrant.		
Palate:	Fresh fruit flavours such as bilberry, blackcurrant and cherry, the mid palate reveals powerful but beautifully chiselled tannins, leading into an attractively fresh finish on notes of mild spice, especially cinnamon and vanilla.
