Vineyard:	The appellation takes its name from the type of soil of which it is composed. Excellent for winegrowing, the soil consists of layers of pebbles and gravel that give the wine its mineral cast. A mild microclimate allows the grapes to ripen slowly, striking a fine balance between sweetness and acidity.		
Vinification:	Baron Philippe de Rothschilds winemakers monitor the selected parcels throughout the vegetation cycle, advising the growers on vineyard practices in order to meet the exacting quality standards of Mouton Cadet Réserve.		
Appearance:	An intense garnet red with a slight crimson hue.		
Bouquet:	The nose opens on floral and ripe red fruit aromas, followed after airing by a touch of leather and paprika together with Burlat cherry and blackcurrant notes.		
Palate:	From a supple and refined attack on delicate tannins, the midpalate has an attractive complexity, revealing spice and floral notes, red and black fruit flavours and a touch of leather, leading into a fresh and mineral finish.
