Vineyard: The Gisselbrecht family have been producing wine in

Alsace for over 300 years. Originally selling their wines to ngociants, in 1936 Willy Gisselbrecht became an independent wine-maker/merchant, one of the first to bottle his own wines. Today the company is run from Dambach-la-Ville by his grandsons, Philippe and Claude,

where the company owns 17 ha of some of Alsaces

finest vineyard sites.

Vinification: The vinification is made according to the traditional style

for the Wines of Alsace, but with the newest methods. All the Wines sold by the Gisselbrecht are vinified at 100% by themselves in their cellar. They use wooden tanks, temperature controlled stainless steel and cement vats.

Appearance: This wine shows a nice yellow colour with glints of gold.

Bouquet: A smoky, spicy, floral nose with honeyed notes.

Palate: A smoothy and fresh mouth, intense with a hint of white

flower.

Cellaring: Up to 3 years
