<b>Vineyard:</b>	The wine takes its name from a Dragon Tree (Genus: <i>Dracaena</i> ) given to the Port Captain of Cape Town, by a passing ships captain over 100 years ago, which grows above what used to be our barrel maturation cellar in the Waterfront. Our winery moved to Somerset west in 2002.		
<b>Vinification:</b>	Varietal composition: 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Shiraz, 30% Pinotage Appellation: Western Cape		
<b>Appearance:</b>	Ruby red.		
<b>Bouquet:</b>	There is a mixture of rich dark fruit, cigar box and minty aromas with the wood well balanced. Sweet and spicy undertones gives this wine great depth.		
<b>Palate:</b>	This wine is well balanced on the pallet showing fresh and crisp acidity. The middle pallet shows an explosion of fruit, leaving a lingering aftertaste.
