Vineyard:	The wine takes its name from a Dragon Tree (Genus: Dracaena) given to the Port Captain of Cape Town, by a passing ships captain over 100 years ago, which grows above what used to be our barrel maturation cellar in the Waterfront. Our winery moved to Somerset west in 2002.		
Vinification:	Varietal composition: 35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Shiraz, 30% PinotageAppellation: Western Cape		
Appearance:	Ruby red.		
Bouquet:	There is a mixture of rich dark fruit, cigar box and minty aromas with the wood well balanced. Sweet and spicy undertones gives this wine great depth.		
Palate:	This wine is well balanced on the pallet showing fresh and crisp acidity. The middle pallet shows an explosion of fruit, leaving a lingering aftertaste.
