Vineyard: Hombo Shuzo was established in 1872, and is located at

the southern tip of the Satsuma peninsula in Kagoshima,

on the island of Kyushu.

Vinification: They produce Imo Shochu from freshly harvested local

Kogane Sengan sweet potatoes which grow especially well in the southern Satsuma climate. This region is also famous for its very pure mineral water, and the Chiran distillery, where these Shochu are produced, is located right in the heart of where this mineral water surfaces,

and where the sweet potatoes are grown.

Bouquet: It has beautiful purity on the nose with hint of tropical

fruit.

Palate: It gives very warm and gentle mouth feel. The palate

shows good balance between the gentle acidity and the sweetness, and exhibits hints of apple, pear and fennel. It

is very light but lively.
