	Vineyard:	While springtime in Mendoza was drier than in the past, January and February experienced heavy rainfall, exceeding the levels recorded in the previous two years. Temperatures during spring were quite similar to prior seasons. However, January and February were cooler when compared to the past two years, which slightly delayed our harvest. This slow progression allowed for very expressive whites with lovely natural acidity, and highly concentrated reds.	
KAIKEN Estate	Vinification:	Grapes are manually harvested, upon arrival, clusters are placed along a sorting conveyor belt and, once de- stemmed, grapes are placed in concrete vats. Winemaking begins with cold maceration, followed by alcoholic fermentation and post-fermentation maceration for 20 days. Forty percent of this wine was aged in French oak barrels for 6 months, while the remaining 60% was left unoaked so as to highlight its fruity flavors and aromas and best preserve the tannins.	
CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021 Augustus	Appearance:	Gifted with deep ruby red and violet hues, this Cabernet Sauvignon reveals low-to-medium depth to the eye	
	Bouquet:	Fresh aromas of red and dark fruit emerge, combined with intriguing herbal and spicy notes.	
	Palate:	it offers a gentle, fresh and juicy mouthfeel with a lingering, pleasant finish. This wine showcases exquisite varietal typicity from its notes of paprika. Vanilla and chocolate hints are also perceived, which tell the story of its aging in oak.
